Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete in the Veterans Classes at Independent Specialties.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

(Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes

STUD DOG CLASS for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Each dog making up the Get must be individually entered in one of the Regular Classes, Best of Breed Competition, or a Non-Regular Class (other than the Stud Dog Class) at this show. Entry fee of \$34.00 for the unit. \$26.00 as an additional entry.

BROOD BITCH CLASS same as for Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Same applies for Brood Bitches.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

BRACE Two dogs with at least one or more common owner. Dogs may be entered for BRACE CLASS ONLY for a fee of \$34.00 per unit. If Brace Class is an additional entry the fee is \$26.00 for the unit. If entering for Brace Class only, full particulars must be given for each dog on individual, regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes – "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "BRACE No. 1", "BRACE No. 2", etc.

PLEASE NOTE: BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY (Revised 09/02)

- Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show.
- Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show.
- Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show.
- Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show.
- The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog.
- In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

- There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Entries must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS or entered in the Amateur Owner-Handler class prior to the closing of entries for that show. Entries into the Amateur Owner-Handler class are automatically entered into the NOHS.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
- Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
- Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.
- Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.
- Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.

Selection Procedure for Owner Handler Best of Breed

- If neither the Best of Breed/Variety nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety from the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition and both the Select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible, the judge is to choose Owner-Handled Best of Breed from the Selects and any eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects from the regular show is eligible for AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition, excuse all eligible champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Owner-Handled Best of Breed from the remaining eligible dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog that competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If no dog remaining in the ring is eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition, Owner-Handled Best of Breed will not be awarded and the breed/variety will not be represented in group competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.

CALLING ALL JUNIORS



Western Reserve Dalmatian Club is offering Junior Showmanship both shows.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, **are required to transfer** their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. **Must notify** the Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOTICE: AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club, Judges Education Department - PHONE: (919) 233-9767.

Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

PEE WEE JUNIOR HANDLING

JUDGE: **Ms. Helene Nietsch**

ENTRY FEE: **FREE**

**On-site entries taken day of show up to conclusion of first specialty.
The event will start after lunch and prior to the start of the second specialty.**

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5 to under 9 years of age at all shows offering Pee Wee. Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- Dogs do not have to be AKC registered.
- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- At an All-Breed event, all AKC fully recognized and Miscellaneous Class breeds are allowed to enter, including dogs with a PAL listing.
- In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Release forms will be available at the show.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. Although the word "judge" will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience—no Junior will be "judged" but rather will be mentored with the age-appropriate amount of information to help prepare them for what they will be expected to know about AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age. The children will be mentored one child, their adult, and dog in the ring at a time. Each child will receive a participation rosette and a treat bag to commemorate the experience!

PLEASE JOIN WRDC IN WELCOMING OUR ITTY BITTY EXHIBITORS

ITTY BITTY is open to children 3 to 4 years old and each entrant will receive a stuffed toy with a leash and collar which they will show and keep.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. - *Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.*
- *The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.*
- *The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.*
- *The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.*
- *The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.*
- *The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.*
- *Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.*
- *Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.*
- *Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.*
- *Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.*
- *Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.*
- *Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dc*
- *Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.*
